

## When Christ Feels at Home in you – Ephesians 3:14-17a



### 1) Strength from the Father through the Spirit vs 14-16

#### **The Posture of Prayer vs 14-15**

Words: boldness, confidence, Father, family, heart, intimacy, pray, submission, worship

Paul now returns to his original intention — to \_\_\_\_\_ for the church.

When Paul says, “I bow my knees,” he is speaking of an attitude of \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.

He is not prescribing a physical posture, but a \_\_\_\_\_ attitude before God.

Why? Because He is our \_\_\_\_\_. Do you hear the \_\_\_\_\_ in that.

#### **The Power of Prayer vs 16**

Words: adoption, His, inner, riches, saints, sanctification, Spirit, strengthened, thinking

Paul does not pray for physical needs, but for the \_\_\_\_\_ man.

We have already seen that these \_\_\_\_\_ are measured according to what God has - which is infinite.

He prays that they would be \_\_\_\_\_ to the same degree as the riches of God’s glory.

That we would have the strength of \_\_\_\_\_ power beyond what we could imagine.

That we would start living in accordance with the riches we possess – \_\_\_\_\_, sonship, heirs, \_\_\_\_\_.

This is all the work of the \_\_\_\_\_ in the believer. Salvation, \_\_\_\_\_, and glorification.

### 2) Christ at Home in the Heart vs 17a

#### **The Reality**

Words: Christ, Holy, salvation, Spirit

Paul is not speaking about \_\_\_\_\_ here.

We receive \_\_\_\_\_ the moment of salvation.

We also receive the \_\_\_\_\_ at salvation.

#### **The Goal**

Words: dwell, faith, guest, home, obedience, presence, quality, Spirit

The word \_\_\_\_\_ speaks of being settled down and at \_\_\_\_\_.

Paul is not pointing to the fact of Christ’s \_\_\_\_\_.

He is pointing to the \_\_\_\_\_ of His presence.

Not just being present like a \_\_\_\_\_ in the house.

Abraham is an example of one who lived out his \_\_\_\_\_.

He walked in \_\_\_\_\_ and taught his household to do the same.

As we depend on the \_\_\_\_\_ and walk by faith, Christ is increasingly at home within us.
