

# A Broken Heart God will not Despise – Psalm 51:7-19



## 1) Repentance seeks inner transformation - vs 7-12

Words: blood, comfort, God, heart, joy, miracle, physical

Vs 7-9 Sin and Guilt removed:

David does not ask for \_\_\_\_\_ until his sin has been dealt with.

“Hyssop” - means of applying the \_\_\_\_\_ of cleansing.

David experienced the \_\_\_\_\_ effects of hiding his sin.

Vs 10-12 Renewed heart and Spirit:

David goes to the \_\_\_\_\_ of the issue. He asks God for a \_\_\_\_\_ that only God can do.

David longs to experience God’s \_\_\_\_\_ again. He wants to thirst after \_\_\_\_\_ again.

## 2) Repentance produces worship and ministry - vs 13-15

Words: forgiveness, repentance, service, worship

David knows that when God cleanses and restores him, he will want to \_\_\_\_\_ and serve Him.

True \_\_\_\_\_ turns away from sin and turns toward God.

Sinful action must be replaced with faithful \_\_\_\_\_.

When we have experienced Christ’s \_\_\_\_\_, we can call others to repentance.

## 3) Repentance offers the sacrifice God desires - vs 16-17

Words: alone, broken, brokenness, Christ, come, cleansed, contrite, dedication, do, living, right, works

God is not pleased with sacrifices when we treat them as \_\_\_\_\_.

The sacrificial system shows our \_\_\_\_\_. To drive us to \_\_\_\_\_.

Even Christians are prone to want to try to \_\_\_ something to be forgiven, to have our consciences \_\_\_\_\_.

Sacrifices - peace or fellowship offerings pointed to \_\_\_\_\_ for and with God.

## 4) Repentance blesses the covenant community - vs 18-19

Words: confess, consequences, first, forgive, Israel, others, strengthens

David turns his attention to \_\_\_\_\_.

As king, David knew his sin could have \_\_\_\_\_ for the people.

In the same way, our sin can affect \_\_\_\_\_ in the church.

We must make things right with God \_\_\_\_\_, and then with each other.
