## 1) The Call to Walk Humbly vs 1

Words: being, calling, continuous, doctrine, empowers, faith, fitting, grace, life, new, prisoner, salvation, sin, urgency, walk

Paul now turns from \_\_\_\_\_ to duty.

Christianity is not only about what we know, but how we \_\_\_\_\_.
